Did you know that in 1974 only 50 Osprey nests were left in New Jersey? Today, Ospreys are a common sight along the New Jersey shore during the summer. Unfortunately,



recent years have been unusual ones for the Osprey. Adult birds have been unable to provide enough fish to sustain their young. Is this related to the bunker (menhaden) in New Jersey's coastal waters?
